

**BOROUGH OF FOLSOM  
COUNCIL MEETING  
WORKSHOP MINUTES  
February 12, 2019**

**MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 6:04 PM**

**OPENING STATEMENT:** Adequate notice of this meeting has been given in accordance with the directives of the "Open Public Meetings Act", pursuant to Public Law 1975, Chapter 231. Said notice of this meeting has been advertised in the Hammonton Gazette and has been posted on the Borough Hall bulletin board showing the time and place of said meeting.

Mayor DeStefano opened the meeting with a discussion on the new requirements from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Bureau of Water Compliance & Enforcement. Mr. Polistina submitted a proposal to bring the Borough into compliance with the Municipal Stormwater Permit.

Mayor DeStefano reported that the Folsom School has offered a container to the Borough.

Mayor DeStefano informed Council that the Folsom School will be maintaining the Beacon sign.

Mayor DeStefano stated that he received a letter from Atlantic County Superintendent of Public Works asking if the Borough wants to spray for mosquitos. Council was in favor of the Mayor signing the agreement.

There was a discussion on the State taking over Folsom fire inspections. The Clerk was directed to forward the email from the State Fire Inspector Justin Henry to begin the process.

A new CCO ordinance was discussed.

Mayor DeStefano reported that the new Planning/Zoning Solicitor is Carol Goloff.

Mayor DeStefano discussed the hiring of a new Social Media Manager. Council asked the Clerk to call other towns and see if they have a Social Media Policy in place.

The sale of Borough land was discussed. Mayor DeStefano stated the two State representatives from the Master Plan offered to help with the sale of land for green acres. Mayor DeStefano will send the contact information to Councilman Schenker.

Councilman Conway inquired about additional handicap parking in front of the Borough. A discussion ensued.
